

## ITALIAN PROGRAM - SALERNO (AMALFI COAST)

### Courses offered in the Program

Intensive Italian Language courses are offered at Accademia Leonardo in Salerno (Italy) at all levels. Students may earn Baruch College credit for the following courses:

### Housing

Students attending the Baruch College Italian language program have the option of staying with a host family or in a student apartment. All accommodation is within ten to fifteen minutes' walking distance from the school.

Students who choose to live with a host family will improve their Italian more rapidly and will also be able to learn important aspects of everyday Italian culture. Students in homestays receive two meals a day.

Students who choose to live in a shared student apartment are responsible for their own meals.
